This is an A5 document. The page is mapped onto A4. There are a lot of mapping features present in ConTeXt. By setting the location to center, we center this A5 page on the A4 paper.

De default layout settings of ConTeXt are meant for quick and dirty, single sided, reports. Here we prefer a centered doublesided layout. We let ConTeXt calculate the width and height. Say \showframe if you want to check this.

The default bodyfont size is 12 points, which is rather large for A5 based documents. Don't confuse \setupbodyfont with \switchtobodyfont; the first sets the main document fonts (sizes) while the latter is meant for	
local use. Using \setupbodyfont halfway a document will lead to strange effects when crossing pages, because this command also affects headers	
and footers.
