
Nearly everything can be a scalable figure: just put the content in a buffer, and load this buffer as graphic.



When generating PDF output, these graphics are included once and reused when needed.

They just behave like any other, external graphic. Here we showed some trivial METAPOST drawing, but tables do well too. But beware: annotations (hyperlinks and so on) fail, due to limitations in the PDF format.
